The Helix Bridge is the world's first curved double helix bridge, linking Marina Centre with Marina South on the bay area. It is on CNN's list of 24 of the world's most amazing bridges and won the World's Best Transport Building in 2010.

The 280m bridge was inspired by the curved DNA structure. If all the steel tubes forming the helix was laid end to end, it would measure over 2km long and weigh 1,700 tonnes.

Canopies are installed along parts of the inner spiral to provide shade for pedestrians. The bridge has stunning views of the Singapore skyline.
